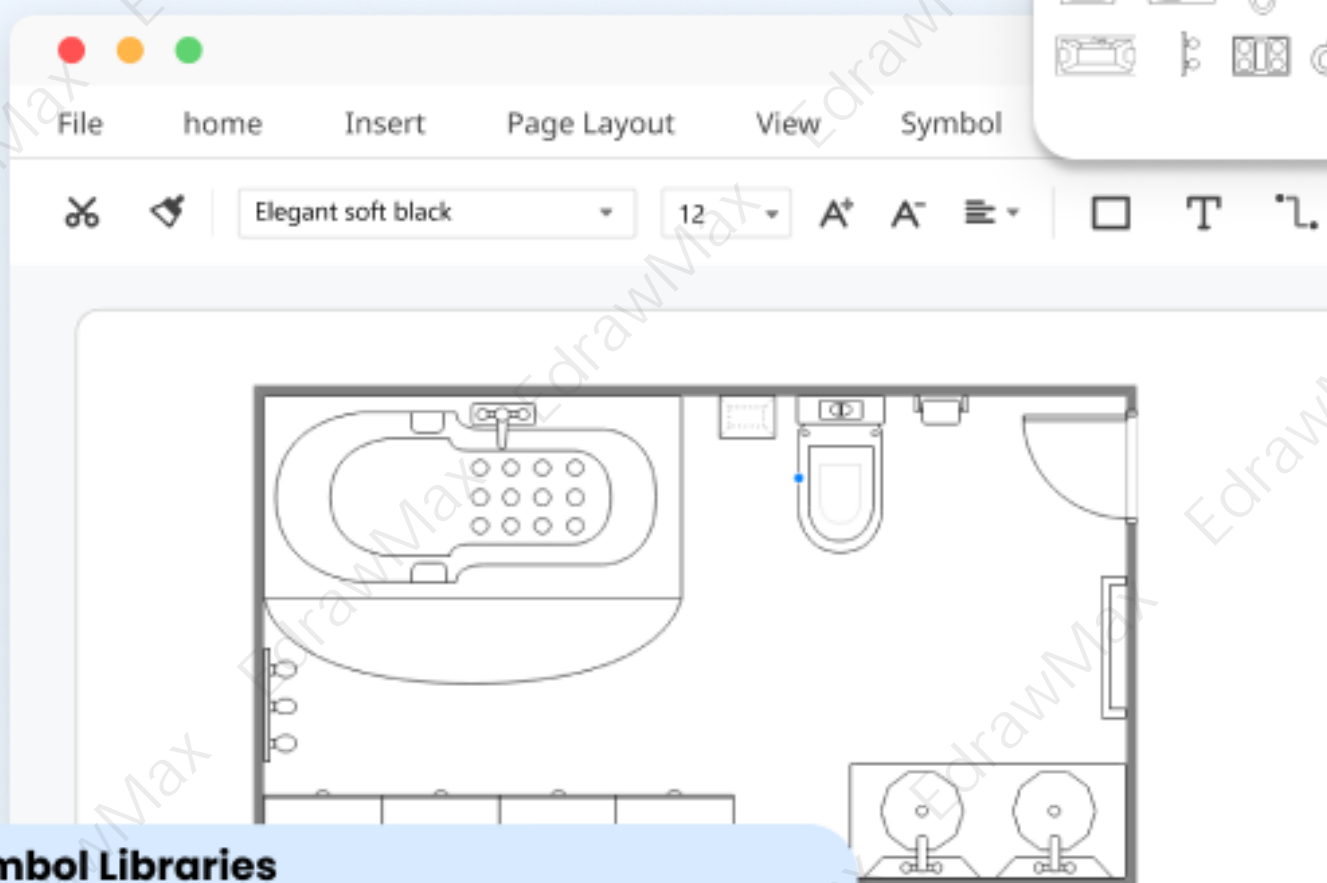

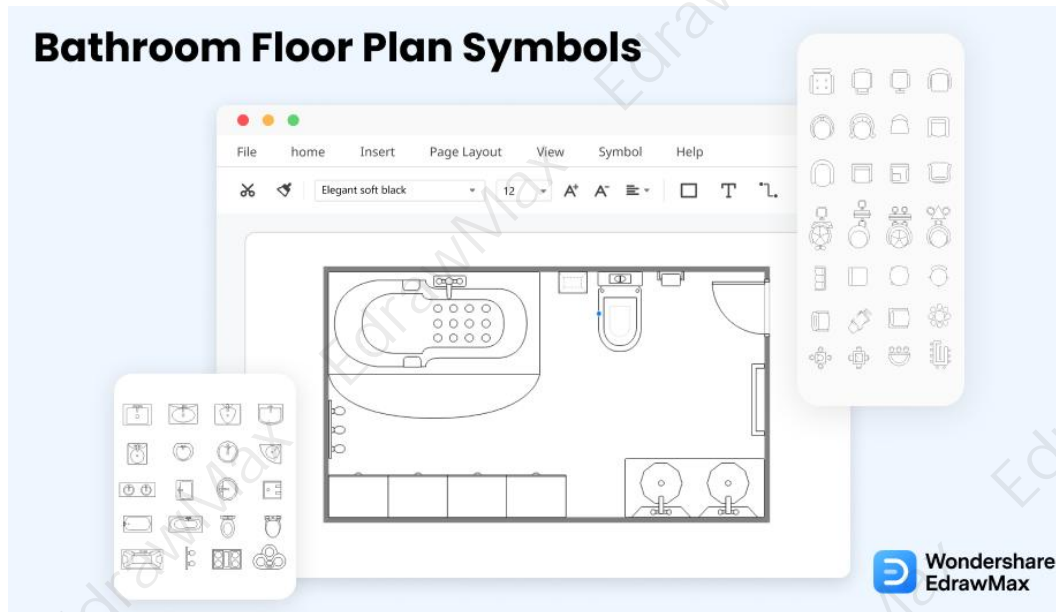

2. The Types of Kitchen Floor Plan Symbols

























2.1 Bathroom Symbols










The bathroom equipment symbols depict the pieces of furniture in the bathroom, including bathroom fixtures and fittings, taps, bathtubs, showers, toilets, sinks, towel racks, and other products. With proper symbols, you can easily create a perfect bathroom floor plan where you can illustrate the size and design of bathroom equipment based on the size and structure of bathroom walls. You can anticipate your bathroom design and use the proper equipment to style it accordingly.

2.2 Wall Shell & Structure Symbols

These symbols are mainly used to depict the bathroom structure and specify the layout of each bathroom wall. These symbols create a 2D model that gives you an overview of the wall shell. Builders use these symbols to specify the size and design of the bathroom. The purpose of using [wall shell symbols](https://www.edrawsoft.com/walldoor.html)² is to outline the size and available space of the bathroom where the owner can arrange the bathtub, sink, and other accessories.

The most typical parts of a bathroom are walls. Exterior walls are represented by thicker lines, whereas internal walls are represented by thinner lines. There is sometimes no discernible difference between them. Instead of a single, solid line, outside walls can be represented by a black outline or double lines.

2.3 Doors and Windows Symbols



















Doors and windows are essential in a bathroom floor plan. We use these symbols to illustrate the window and door position in the bathroom walls to create a fresh airflow in the bedroom and provide a comfortable environment. The bathroom windows are usually small, and people prefer to use sliding glass doors in a bathroom with divided sections. There are various [windows and doors symbols](https://www.edrawsoft.com/walldoor.html)³ based on their shape and size. These symbols include doors for closets and windows in different shapes and designs.

Doors resemble larger spaces between walls, with a curving line indicating which way the door will swing and providing clearance. Depending on their design and function, they may appear differently on floor plans.

The windows are portrayed as if they were part of the walls.

- Three parallel lines separate regular sliding-glass windows from solid walls.
- Casement windows have arcs that look like doors and demonstrate how they open outward.
- The bay windows are tilted like the edge of a stop sign, interrupting the wall's straight line trajectory.















2.4 Cabinet Symbols

A bathroom cabinet or a vanity is an important part of a bathroom layout. Cabinet symbols help the owners design cabinets even in the smaller bathroom by helping them use the space efficiently and focus on vertical areas. The cabinets usually go under or over the sink. These cabinets contain toiletries, hygiene products, and also medications. It would help if you had a bathroom cabinet with lots of space in a big family house.

The **cabinets symbols** specify the position of cabinets in any room of the house. These symbols include shelves, wood and glass cabinets, small and large dressing cabinet.

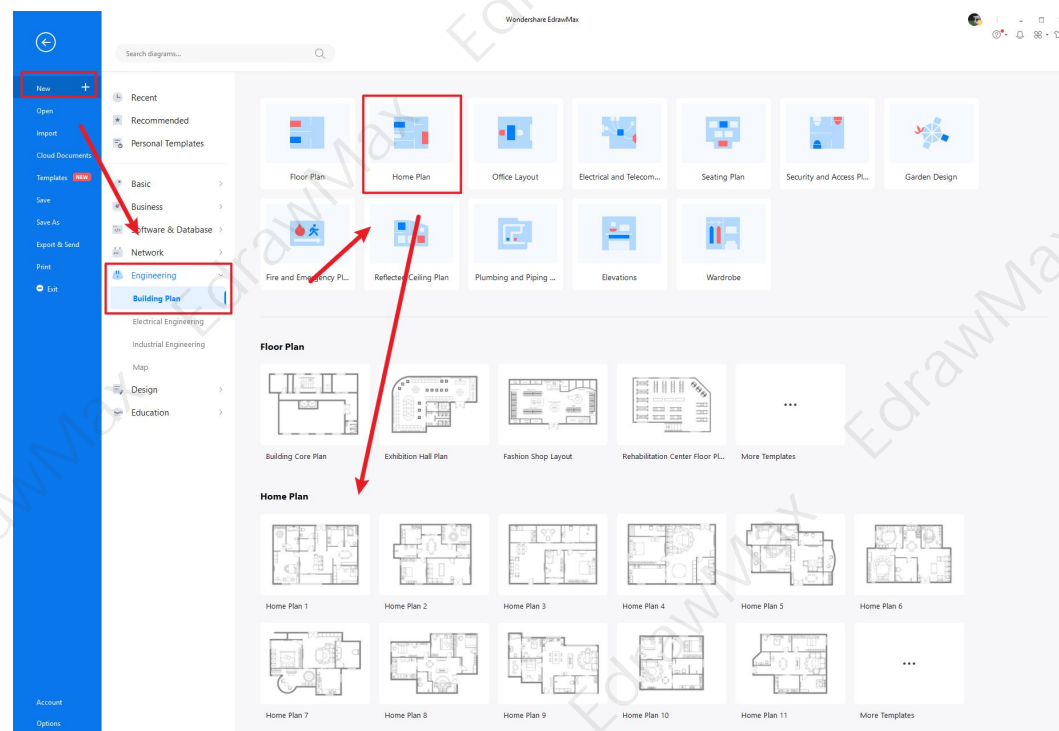

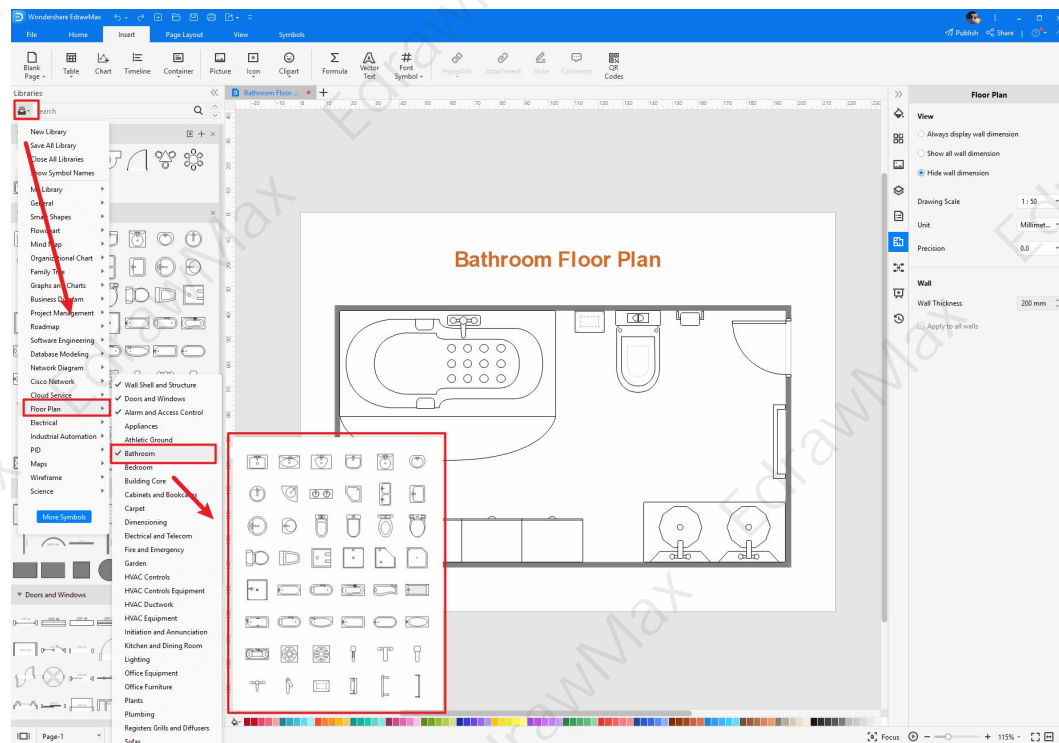
Step 1: Login EdrawMax

If you are new here, you should use your Email to register EdrawMax, but if you're already the EdrawMax's user, you just need to login EdrawMax for free. Open EdrawMax select "Engineering", and find "Building Plan", and click "Home Plan", then open a new canvas or just open a built-in template.



Step 2: Select Bathroom Plan Symbols

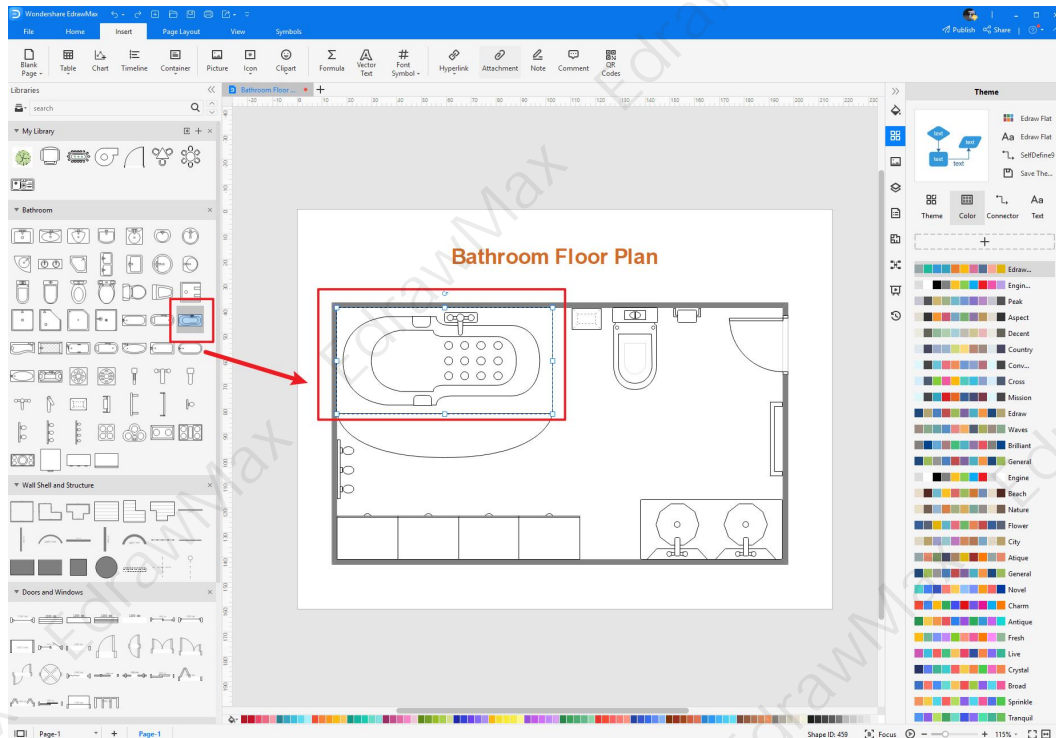
Unlike physical drawing, EdrawMax helps to create a bathroom floor plan easily. In the symbol section of EdrawMax, you will find over 260,000 vector-based symbols that you can use in your designs. In EdrawMax, you can find bathroom floor plan symbols in **Symbol Libraries** on the left toolbar. You can click on the "+" option to open a new canvas to make your bathroom floor plan. On the left side of the canvas, you will see a symbol library with many bathroom floor plan symbols. You can search for specific symbols in the search bar.



Step 3: Drag and Drop

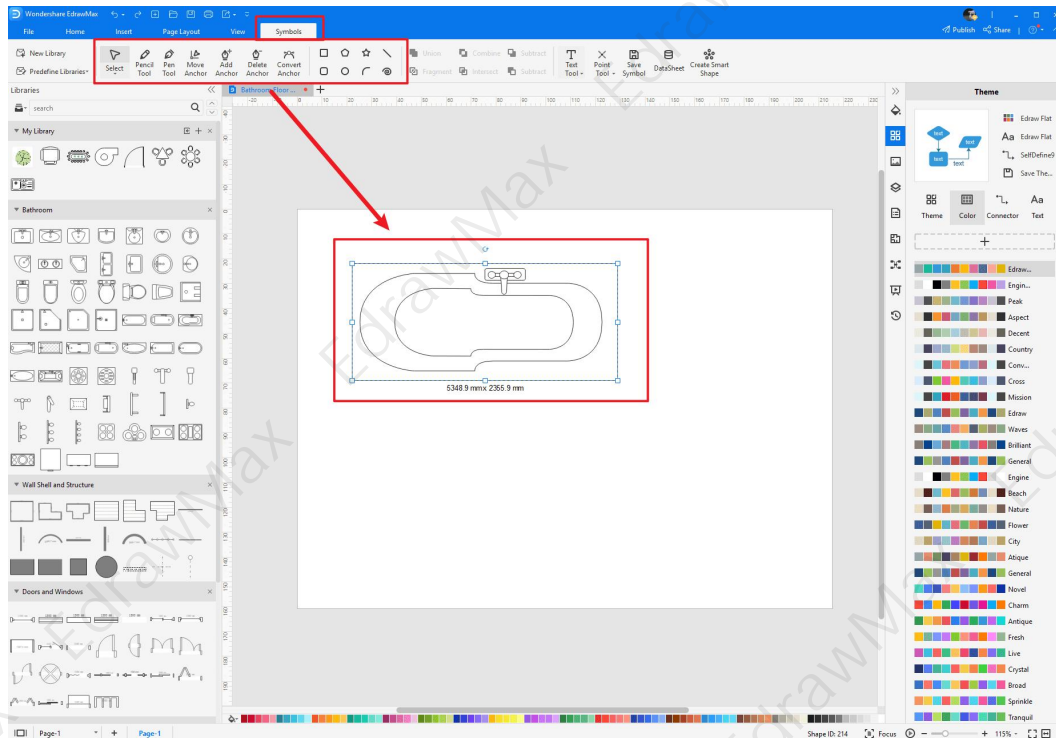
4.2 How to Create More Bathroom Floor Plan Symbols in EdrawMax

EdrawMax provides you with thousands of symbols to create your diagram. Sometimes you want to use unique or personalized symbols in your diagram that are not in the library. EdrawMax gives you a simple solution to this problem. Follow these steps when you don't find the bathroom floor plan symbols you want or you wish to create your symbols to make your diagram.

Step 1: Find Symbol Tool

If you can't find any symbol similar to the one you want, you can use the pencil tool, pen tool, and anchor tool to draw your personalized bathroom floor plan symbols. It is much easier to draw the symbol you want on EdrawMax instead of searching for the one that suits your requirements. You can also save your symbol in the library for later use.

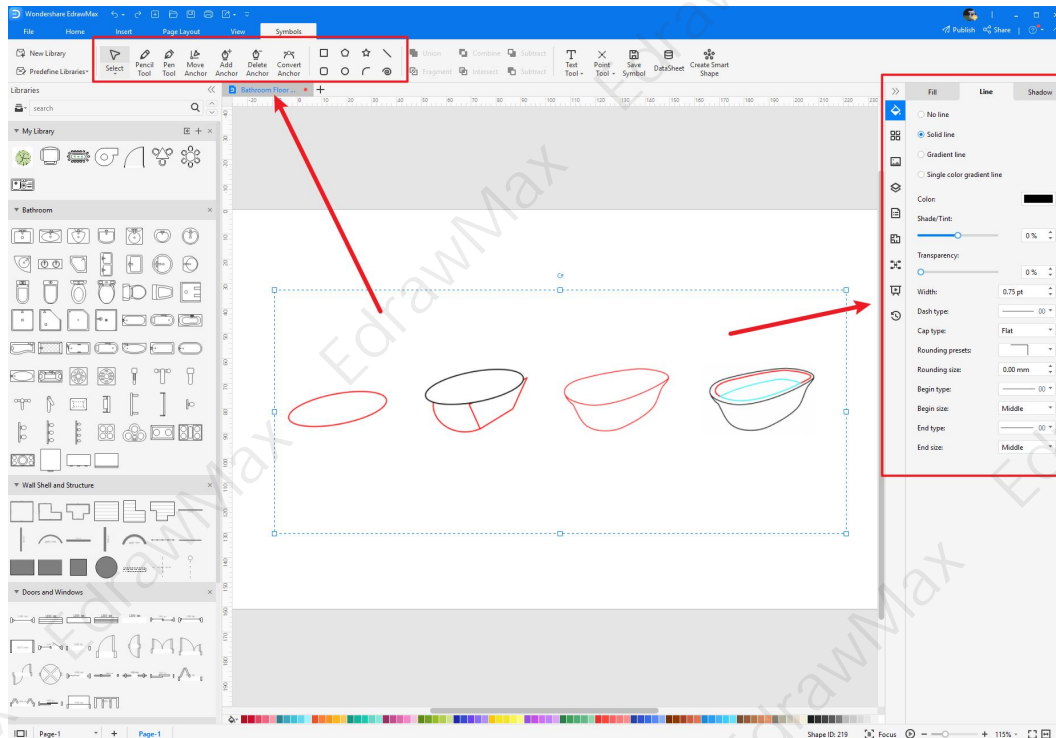
- Select **"Symbols"** on the upper Toolbar;
- Use **"Pencil Tool"**, **"Pen Tool"**, **"Anchor Tool"** to create garden symbol from very beginning;
- Choose **"Union"**, **"Combine"**, **"Subtract"**, **"Fragment"**, **"Intersect"**, **"Smart Shape"** to make your symbols.



Step2: Create Bathroom Plan Symbols

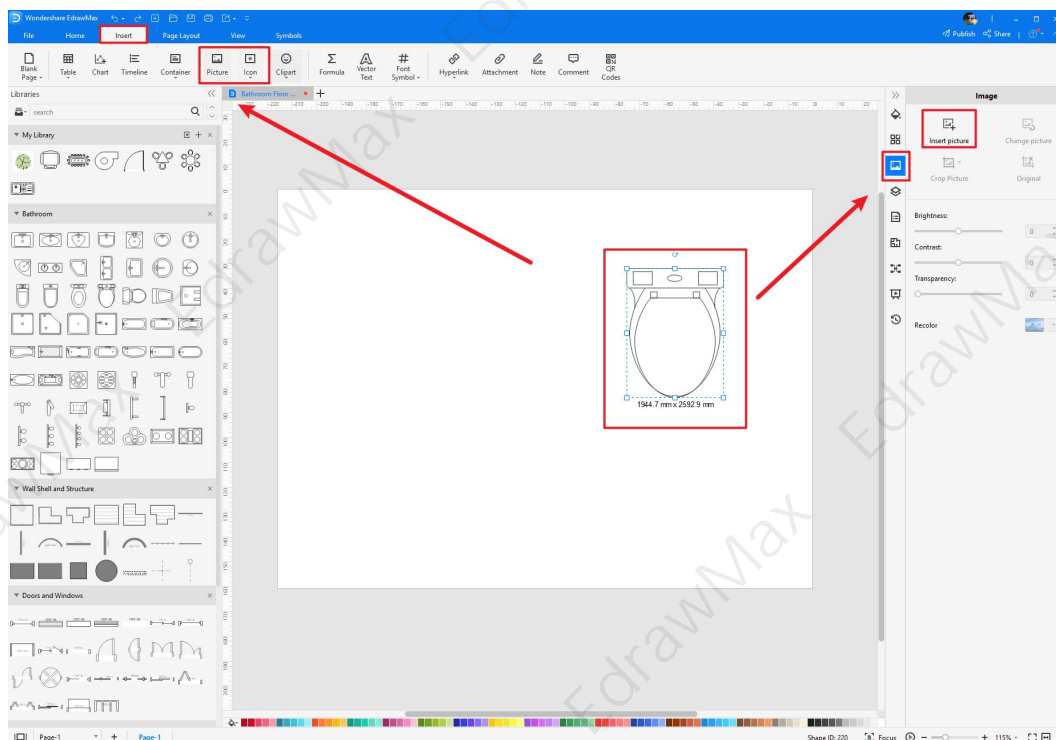
When you create a bathroom floor plan symbol, make sure that the size, design, and other attributes of your icon go along with other bathroom floor plan icons. Follow these steps to draw perfect symbols.

- Draw an oval shape to create the opening on top of the bathtub.
- Then, add a circle in front of the object to illustrate the body of the bathtub.
- Draw another oval shape inside the first one to add some depth and thickness to your object.
- Add some details like a couple of lines.



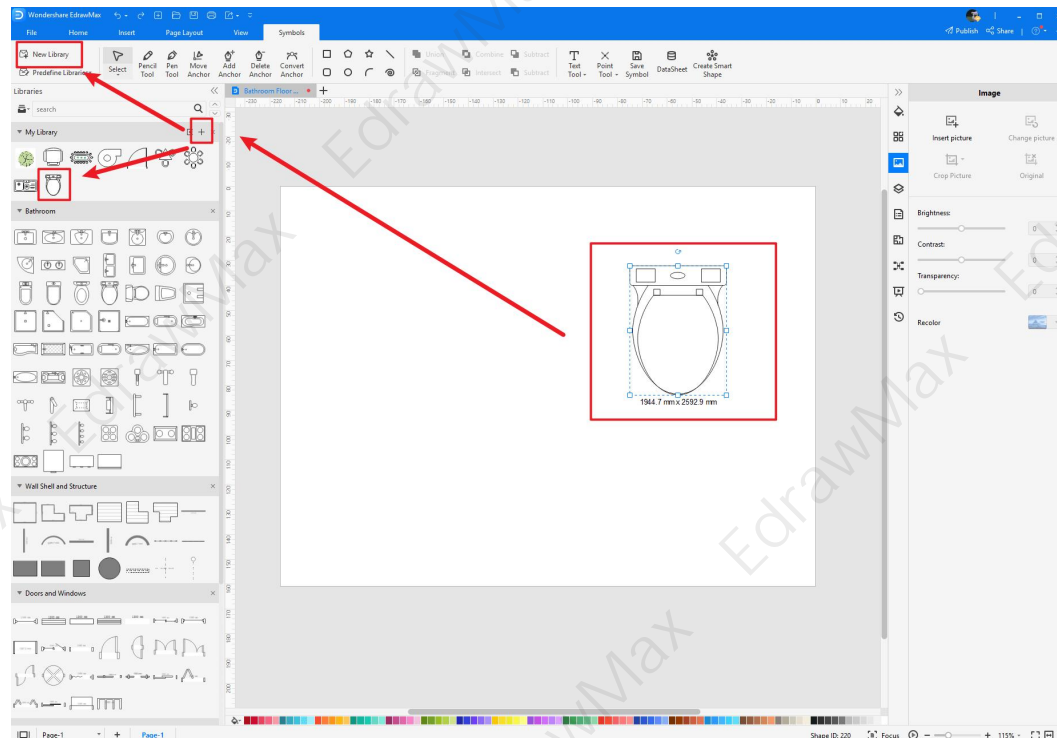
Step3: Import Bathroom Plan Symbols

Except for creating new bathroom floor plan symbols in EdrawMax, you can import bathroom floor plan symbols from your end. Find "Insert" on the top navigate toolbar, and import images to turn into symbols. Or click the third option of the right toolbar to insert images faster.



Step4: Save to Your Symbol Libraries

Once you completed your bathroom floor plan symbols design or import your symbol images, you should still click **"Symbols"** on top, and choose **"Save Symbol"** to your symbol Libraries. 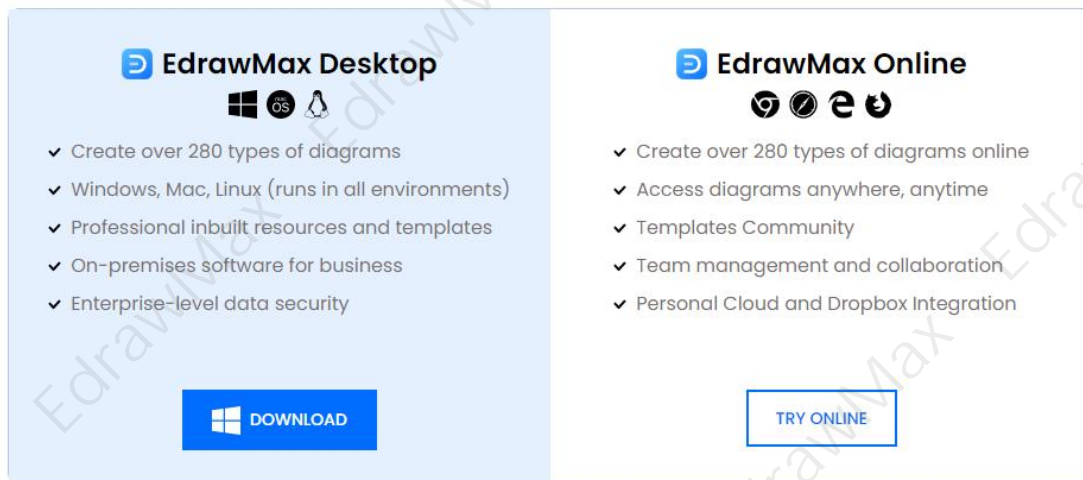
