



## 1.1 Fire Evacuation Plan Examples


A fire is one of those disasters that happen without warning, and no one gets time to prepare to tackle it. The only thing that works during a fire is a pre-made fire escape plan


## **Example 1:Fire Evacuation Plan**


## **Example 2: Office Evacuation Plan**




## 1.2 Hurricane Evacuation Plan Examples

When a hurricane approaches a city, everyone gets a warning notice which gives them time to prepare and evacuate. A warning is not enough to deal with a natural disaster; you need a pre-made plan that you can follow and evacuate safely. 
## **Example 4: Hurricane Evacuation Plan**

The Atlantic hurricane season lasts from June 1 to November 30. It is always a good idea to be ready for a hurricane. Planning for hurricane season and other potential disasters can be stressful, and it may be especially so during the coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic. Your hurricane plan may be different this year because of the need to protect yourself and others from COVID-19. Before a hurricane hits, the CDC recommends that you print important documents (such as emergency phone numbers and insurance information). Power outages during and after a storm can make it difficult to access information online when you need it the most.



**Example 5: Hurricane Evacuation Plan** 

Making a hurricane evacuation plan, assembling an evacuation kit, and other preparations may help keep you, your family, and your pets safe. In addition, preparing your home for a hurricane should be part of your hurricane preparedness plan in order to protect the property you leave behind. A mandatory Hurricane evacuation plan is often declared a day or two in advance. The evacuation order, on the other hand, can come at any time. Plan ahead of time for the hurricane to ensure the safety of your family and property. If your family isn't together when the evacuation order is issued, arrange a meeting place where everyone can reconnect. It could be a church, a school, or a location in a nearby town.



## **Example6: Hurricane Evacuation Map**

The United States Army Corps of Engineers recently updated all Hurricane Inundation Maps for Massachusetts communities along the coast or with a river or other waterway connecting to the ocean. Hurricane Inundation Maps show the areas of land that floodwaters could inundate during a hurricane. The National Weather Service's (NWS) Sea, Lake, and Overland Surge from Hurricanes (SLOSH) model estimate potential storm surge and inundation flooding during Category 1, Category 2, Category 3, or Category 4 hurricane.



## 1.3 Wildlife Evacuation Plan Examples

A wildfire is a natural disaster that can happen anytime and gives you very little time to prepare and evacuate. 
#### **Example 7: Wildlife Evacuation Plan**

This plan focuses on the evacuation of a humane society shelter and the role of the humane society in establishing a temporary shelter for owned animals. This document is an early draught, with many plan details missing. The samples presented here are real Wildlife evacuation plans from which we have removed identifying information about the organization and community. It may be useful to see how other organizations and communities have dealt with similar situations as you develop or update your disaster response plan.



#### **Example 8: Wildlife Emergency Plan**

The wildlife emergency plan is a wildlife risk assessment in both time and space. Real-time tracking of wildlife's whereabouts about the oil. Nesting/haul-out areas are protected - hazing and dissuasion (scaring animals away from oil). There is a high risk of delays and inefficiency without a pre-spill agreed-upon wildlife plan. A pre-spill-developed wildlife response plan, implemented through training and exercises, provides the best guarantee for a quick and effective wildlife response mobilization. A Wildlife emergency plan of this type is best integrated with the overall oil spill response plan that an individual has in place for its oil exploration, production, or transportation activities in a country or region.




## 1.4 Earthquake Evacuation Plan Examples

An **earthquake evacuation plan** is as essential as a fire escape plan. An earthquake strikes without warning and can continue for some time. With the earthquake evacuation plan, you can identify potential hazards due to earthquakes in your house or building. Building codes in earthquake-prone areas may include specific requirements designed to increase the earthquake resistance of new buildings. Generally,




the older buildings and homes that are not up to code can be modified to make them more resistant. Elevated freeways and bridges also use modification and earthquake-resistant design. Building codes are not intended to make buildings earthquake-proof because they will sustain no damage.



## **Example 11: Earthquake Evacuation Map**

The overarching theme of the Earthquake Evacuation Plan is to be prepared for an earthquake. Preparedness begins in an individual's daily life and includes items and training that would be useful in an earthquake. Earthquake evacuation plans progress from individual preparedness to family preparedness, community preparedness, business, non-profit, and governmental preparedness. Some organizations combine these levels. Businesses are encouraged to have a Disaster Recovery Plan as part of their business continuity planning. The FEMA in the United States categorizes preparedness as a pyramid, with citizens at the base, followed by local government, state government, and federal government in that order.




## 1.5 Emergency Evacuation Plan Examples


## **Example 12: Emergency Evacuation Plan**


## **Example 13: Emergency Evacuation Map**


## **Step2: Search for More Templates**





## 5. Appendix

An evacuation plan is mainly used to help people evacuate buildings, areas, or cities during an emergency or a natural disaster. After creating an evacuation plan for your house or building, the next step is to figure out where to position the plan holder so everyone can easily see and read it. Mounting the evacuation plan five feet above the floor is perfect for everyone to see it clearly. We use the 1:16 ratio to depict feet in inches. You can use a 1:32 ratio for smaller buildings, but it is the smallest scale you can use.
