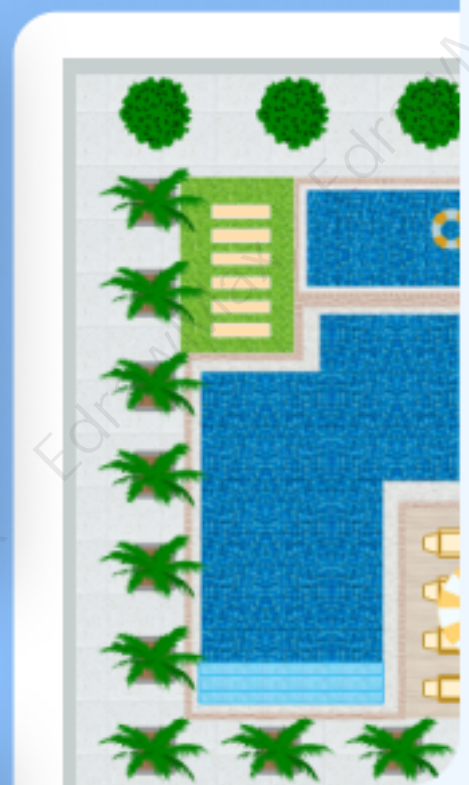

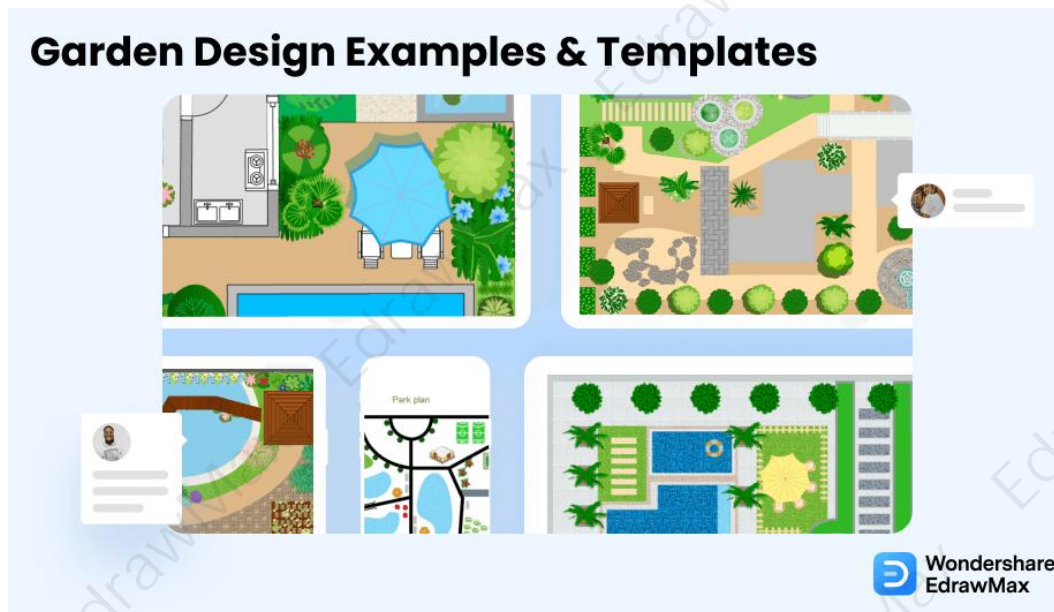

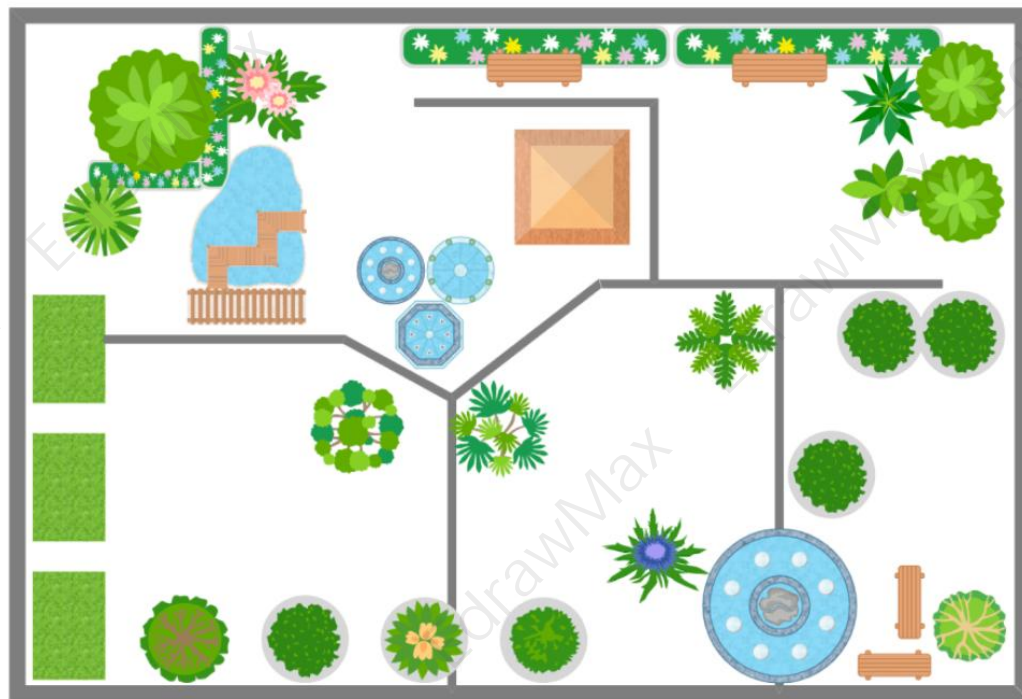

Flower Garden Plan



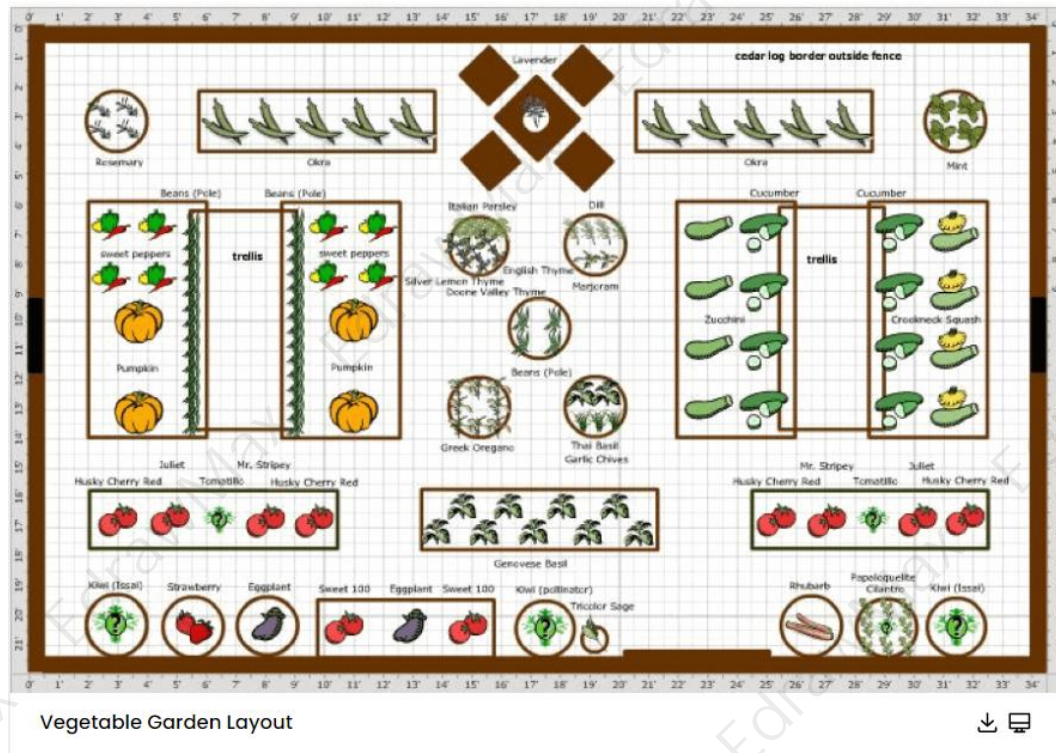
## 1.2 Vegetable Garden Design Examples

With vegetable gardens, you can increase the growth of plants to enjoy healthy and homemade vegetables. These gardens also require constant care, which is a great exercise for their owners. ### Example 3: Vegetable Garden Layout

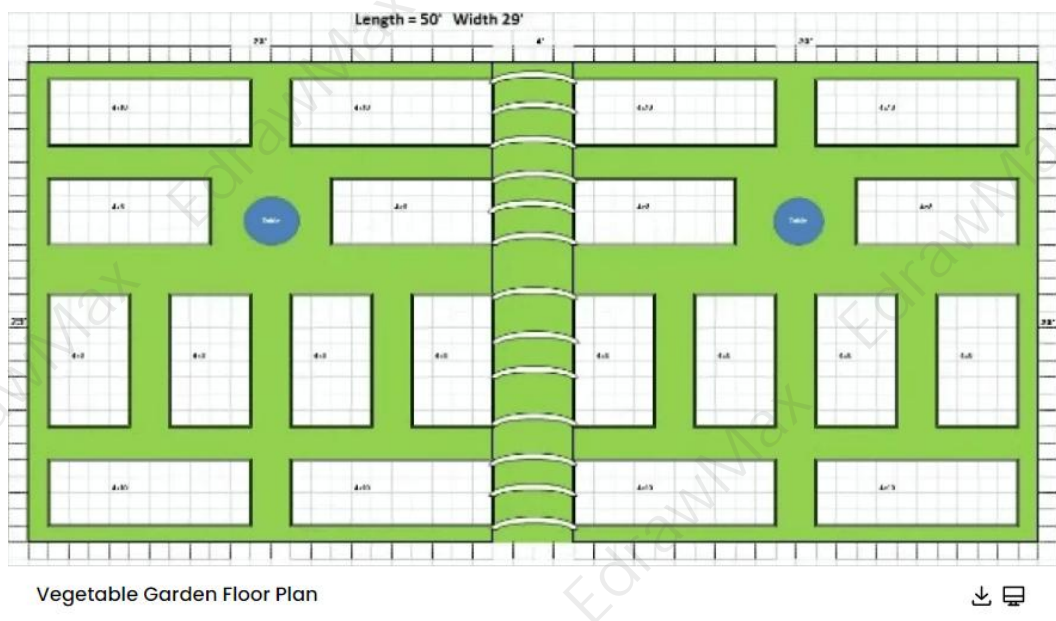
A garden plan with straight, long rows from north to south is the most basic. A north to south orientation will provide the best light exposure and air circulation for the garden. A garden that runs east to west will be overshadowed by the crops in the row before it.

Plant tall plants on the north side of the garden, such as corn or beans, to keep smaller crops from being shaded. Tomatoes, squash, and cabbage, for example, should be grown in the center. Carrots, lettuce, and radishes should be planted in the garden's southern section.



#### Example 4: Vegetable Garden Floor Plan

Another vegetable garden layout idea is called a four square garden plan. Imagine the bed divided into four quarters, as if you have a piece of paper and have drawn a square on it and then a cross inside the square. Each bed is represented by a square within the larger square. Beds are divided into four categories based on the amount of nutrients they require.



### 1.3 Front & Back Yard Garden Design Examples

A **front & back yard garden design** are best for a house with a gallery path that connects the backyard with the front yard. You can design a matching layout for both yards using a similar design, plantation, and flowers with these garden designs. The front yard of each house focuses on beauty to show off your property, while the back yard is a private space that your family uses to relax. #### Example 5: Front Yard Garden

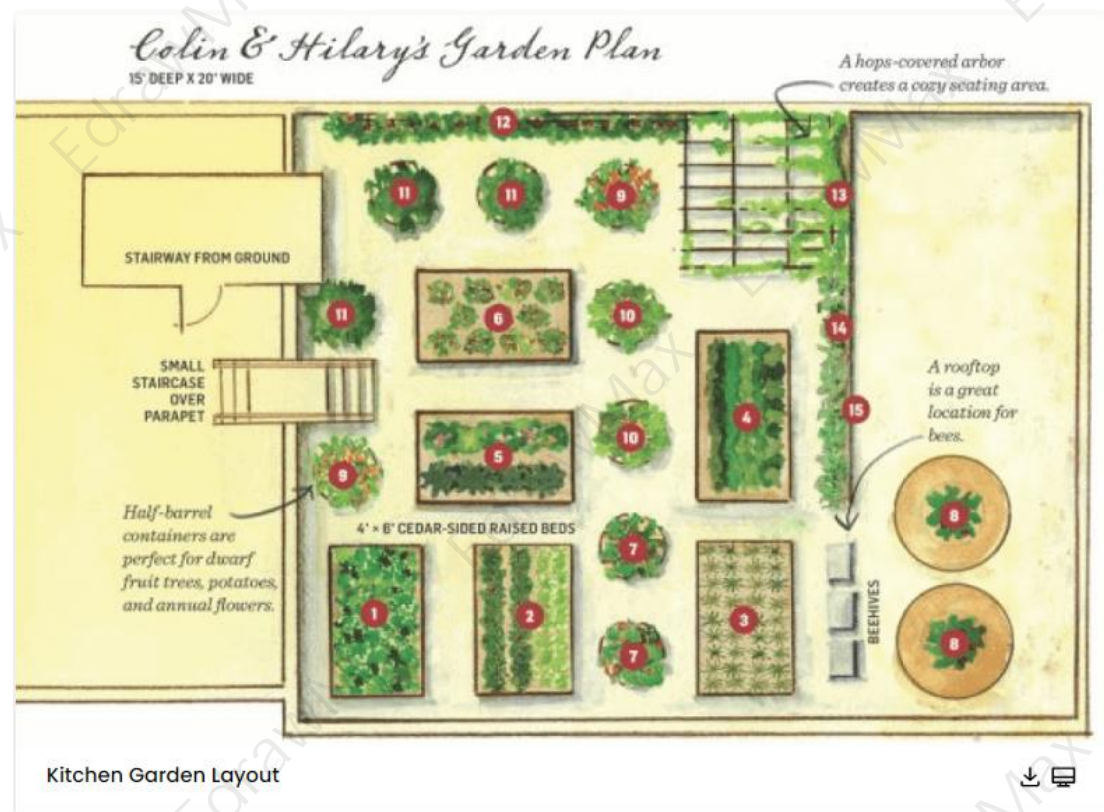

### Example 7: Kitchen Garden Layout

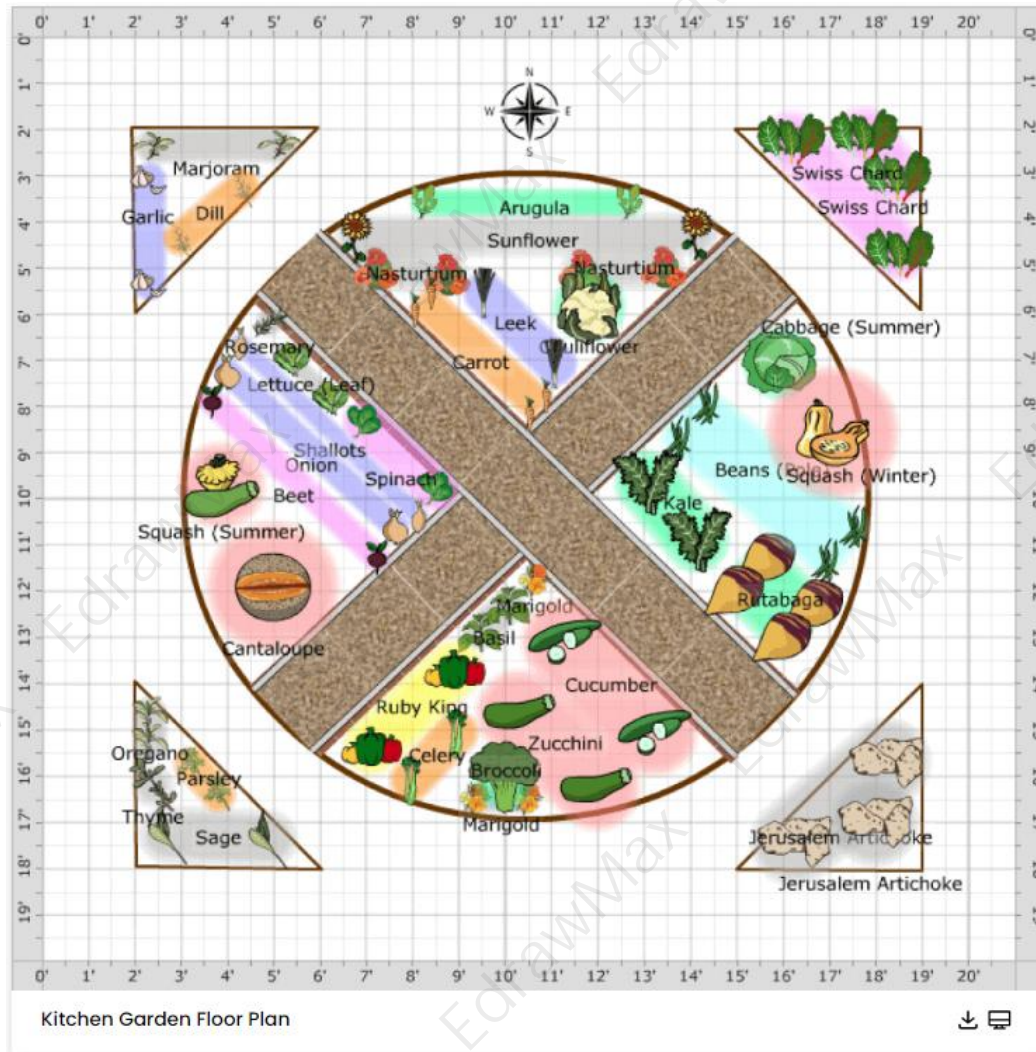

### Example 9: Garden Layout Example

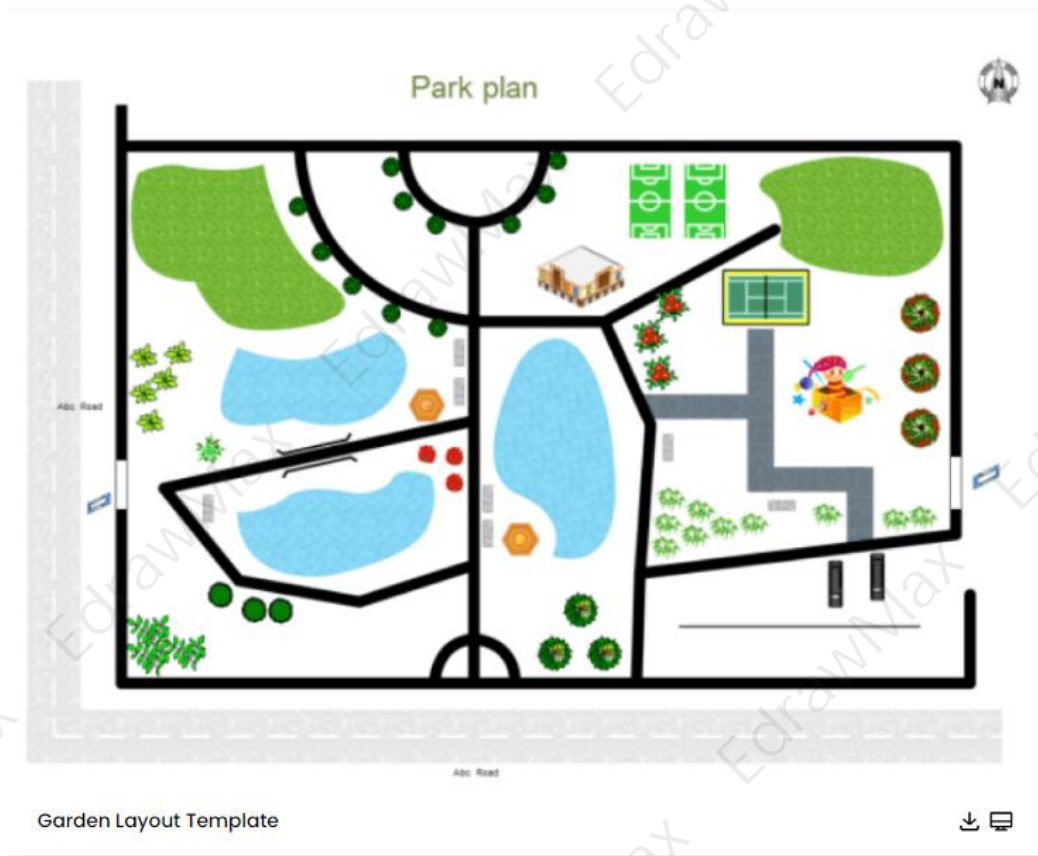

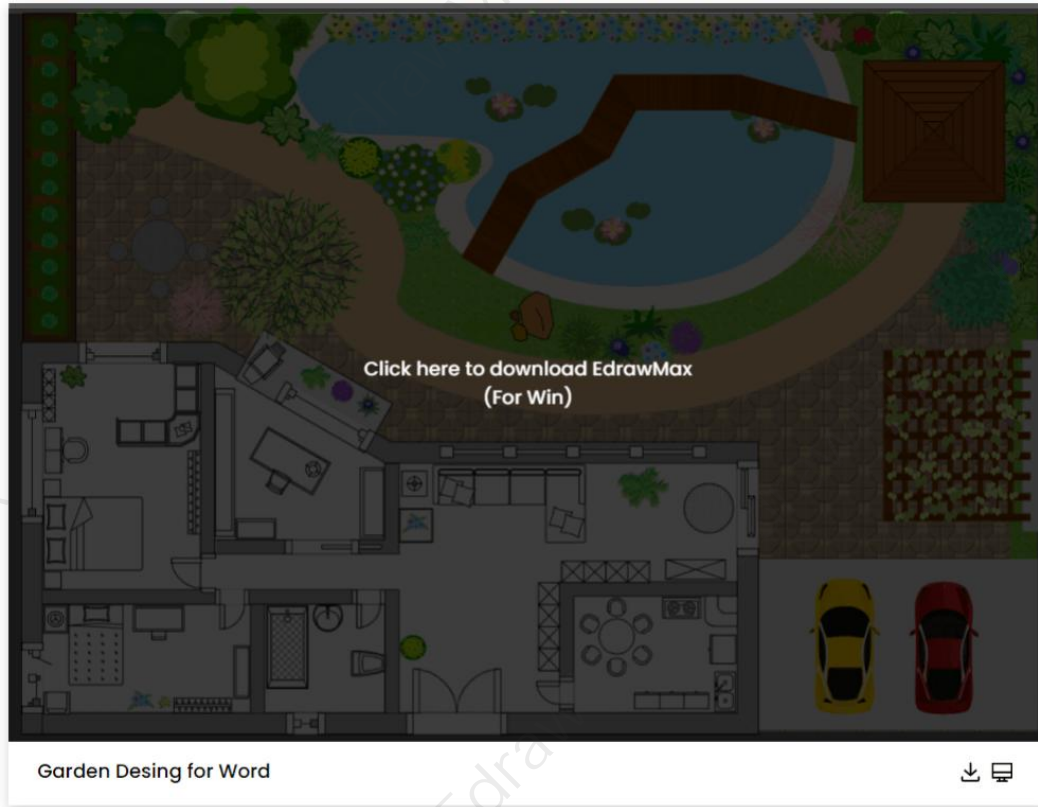

### Step 1: Install EdrawMax

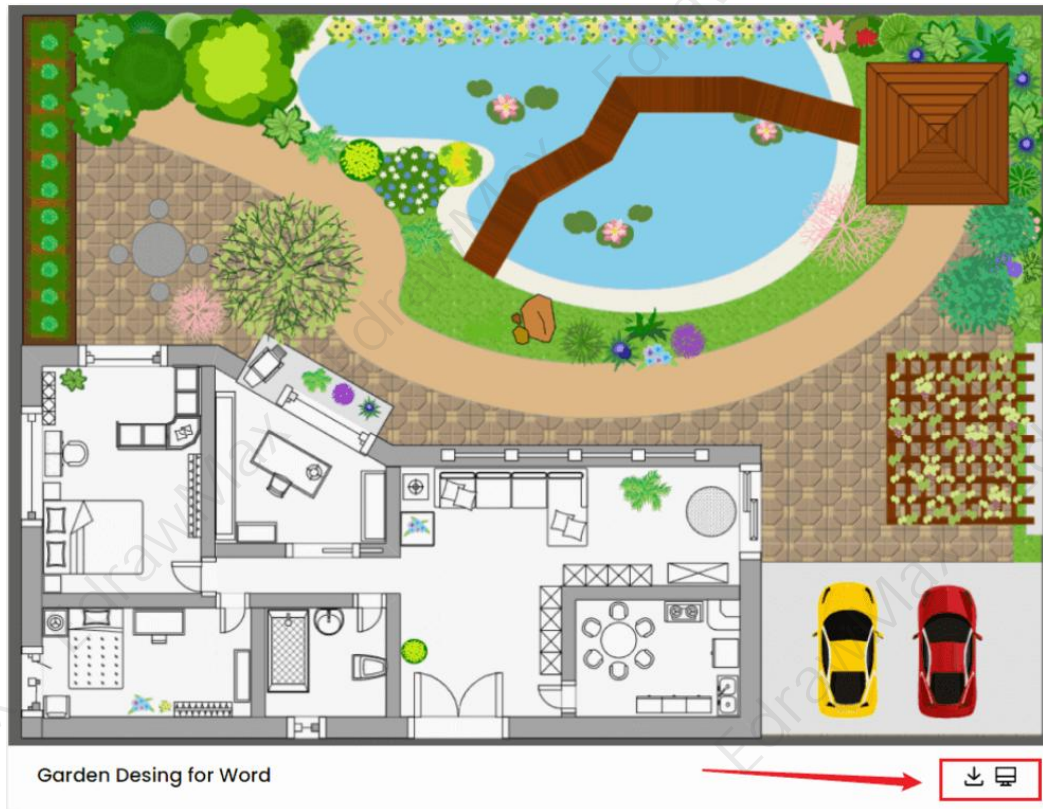

### Step 2: Download the Template

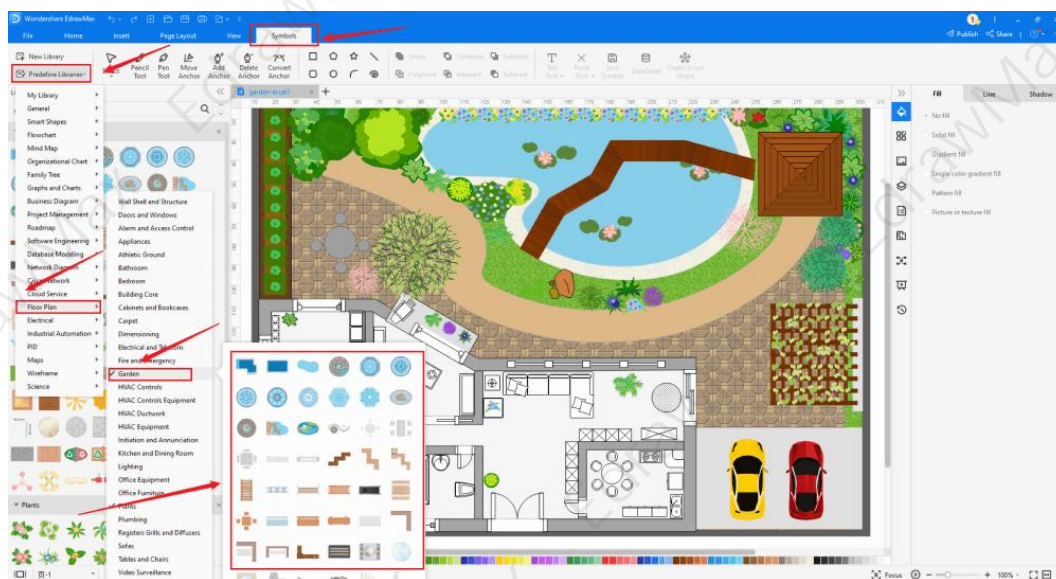
After installing EdrawMax, you can go and download the template by clicking on the bottom right corner or look for a template in the EdrawMax library without going online in desktop.

### Step 3: Open the Template

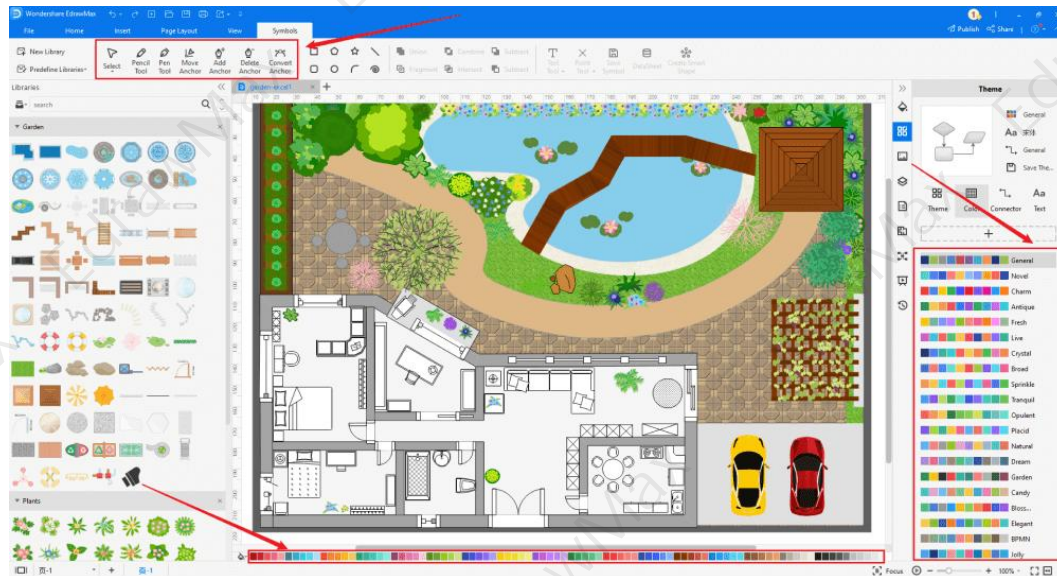

<b>Asparagus</b>	15" - 18"	<b>Leeks</b>	3" - 6"
<b>Bean (bush)</b>	4" - 6"	<b>Lettuce (head)</b>	10" - 12"
<b>Bean (Lima)</b>	4" - 6"	<b>Lettuce (leaf)</b>	4"-6"
<b>Bean (pole)</b>	6" - 12"	<b>Melons</b>	18" - 24"
<b>Beets</b>	2" - 4"	<b>Mustard greens</b>	6"-9"
<b>Broccoli</b>	12" - 18"	<b>Okra</b>	12" - 18"
<b>Brussels sprouts</b>	15" - 18"	<b>Onions</b>	2" - 4"
<b>Cabbage</b>	15"-18"	<b>Peas</b>	2"-4"
<b>Carrots</b>	2"-3"	<b>Peppers</b>	12" - 15"
<b>Cauliflower</b>	15" - 18"	<b>Potatoes</b>	10" - 12"
<b>Cucumber</b>	12 - 18"	<b>Pumpkins</b>	24" - 36"
<b>Spinach</b>	4"-6"	<b>Tomatoes</b>	4"-6"
<b>Eggplant</b>	18" - 24"
