

Garden Door Symbols

A door provides a passageway or transition from one place to another. It is a barrier to the entrance of any building, hose, place, vehicle, or cabinets. A garden door or a patio gives access to the house's outer parts, such as backyards and gardens. The standard size of a garden door is a height of 3 to 6 feet and a width of 3 to 4 feet in the case of a single door. But a double door size can vary. They provide entry and exit points to many parts of a house like a backyard, kitchen, and pool area.


Garden Fence Symbols

A fence is a strip representing a partition that prevents outsiders from entering house premises. Fence in a garden is designed according to the house's and garden's theme. But usually, the maximum height of the fence should not exceed 2 meters.

Deciduous Tree Symbols

Deciduous plants, which include trees, shrubs, and herbaceous perennials, are those that shed all of their leaves for portion of the year in botany and horticulture. Evergreen plants, on the other hand, drop their leaves on a different schedule than deciduous plants, giving them the appearance of being green all year because not all of their leaves are shed at the same time.


Shrub Symbols


Step 1: Login EdrawMax


Step 2: Select Garden Symbols








Step4: Save to Your Symbol Libraries
